What is Google Sheets?



Google Sheets is an online spreadsheet system that lets you create and edit spreadsheets and work with other people. Google Sheets let you perform basic calculations, creates tables and graphs. It is a part of a free, web-based software office suite offered by Google within its Google Drive service.

Google's web-based software office suite is similar to the **Microsoft Office** suite. For example:

Google Sheets – similar to Microsoft Excel

Google Docs – similar to Microsoft Word

Google Slides – similar to Microsoft PowerPoint
