BE THE ARTIST Torn Paper Landscape

J.M.W. Turner was a fabulous landscape artist and a master of light. This project explores his landscape design.

Supplies

- Sheet of paper for gluing
- Colored construction paper
- A glue stick or regular glue

Instructions

- Select the colors you want to work with to make your landscape. The background for this example is white.
- Take paper and tear it lengthwise. In the example, dark blue paper was used several times to make many strips.
- Glue a few of these strips to the background paper. Add torn strips from the other colored paper.
- Move the paper around until you have a pleasing design you like by adding and subtracting colored paper. You can try making little houses, a garden with flowers, or perhaps a sailboat out on the water in your landscape.

To take this project further, try the same design using different colors to represent another time of day. You just might get a WOW! in what you come up with.
